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Summary of the project

The production of the **XVI Brazilian Meeting on Palaces and Historic House Museums** was coordinated by Paulo Costa and Fernanda Guimarães, respectively curator and superintendent of the Ema Klabin House Museum.

Karin Magnavita was an important consultant during the programme definition and Adriana Miyatake was hired especially for the event organisation. Marcelo Tápia, Angelica Fabbri and Ivanei Silva were also active in the meeting definition and Casa Guilherme de Almeida was responsible for the organisation of the third roundtable.

All participants were offered a symbolic payment for their participation, according to their role in the meeting: speaker, roundtable participant, or moderator. Only Marcelo Sá de Sousa, who had his travel expenses paid for by the Brazilian Chamber of Deputies, refused this payment.

Taking the new definition of museum established by the ICOM as a starting point, the **XVI Brazilian Meeting on Palaces and Historic House Museums** proposed a broad discussion on memory and the tangible and intangible heritage preserved by the various types of house museums. For the first time, the meeting was organised by the Ema Klabin House Museum. The main purpose of the event was to reassess the narratives and forms of communication with the public, as well as the memories and forgetfulness that are in the very definition of heritage.

The meeting was held in June 28 and 29, consisting of three lectures (two opening and one closing) and five roundtables with the participation of professionals from several Brazilian museums.

Although it focused on specific issues of the situation of Brazilian museums, the meeting was also in line with DEMHIST's conference "Remembrances of Things Lost", which will take place in October in Belgrade, Serbia.

Participants

In total, 25 people participated of the 3 lectures and 5 roundtables carried out during the twoday event. 31 people from the Ema Klabin House Museum team or hired specifically for the event participated of the production.

As for public attendances, the symposium received 335 registrations, 212 for online and 123 for in-person participations.

According to the attendance list, 99 people attended the event in person throughout the entire event. 325 certificates were delivered by e-mail (266 for online or in-person attendees, 28 for programme participants and 31 for the team involved) on July 14 and 15.


